FASD Resource Directory

The Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD) Resource Directory is a reference guide of community and family resources for family members, parent peer supporters, families with special needs children and service providers such as physicians including OB/GYNs and pediatricians, first responders, public health and social workers, teachers, school nurses and administrators, among others.

The services and resources in this directory are categorized by region and then by county. FASD protective factors are a point of reference.

About Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD)

Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD) are a group of conditions that can occur in a person who was exposed to alcohol before birth. These effects can include physical problems and problems with behavior and learning. Often, a person with an FASD has a mix of these problems. Fetal alcohol spectrum disorders cause brain damage and growth problems. The problems caused by fetal alcohol spectrum disorders vary from child to child, but defects caused by fetal alcohol spectrum disorders are not reversible.

FASD can occur when a person is exposed to alcohol before birth. Alcohol in the blood passes to the baby through the umbilical cord. All types of alcohol are equally harmful, including all wines and beer. To prevent FASD, people should avoid alcohol if they are pregnant or might be pregnant.

FASD Protective Factors

Protective factors are events, environments or activities that can reduce the impact of FASD and help people with FASD reach their full potential.

They include:

- Early diagnosis
- Involvement in special education and social services
- A loving, nurturing and stable home environment
- Absence of violence

Early Diagnosis

When diagnosed at an early age, children can be placed in appropriate educational classes and get the social services they need. Early diagnosis also helps families and school staff to understand why the child might act or react differently from other children sometimes.

Involvement in Special Education and Social Services

Children with FASD have a wide range of learning needs and behavior challenges that may need to be addressed. With special education geared toward their specific needs and learning styles, they are more likely to reach their full potential.

Loving, Stable Home Environment

Children with FASD can be more sensitive than other children to disruptions, changes in lifestyle or routines. A loving, stable home life is very important for a child with FASD.

Absence of Violence

People with FASD who live in stable, non-abusive households or who do not become involved in youth violence are much less likely to develop secondary conditions than children who have been exposed to violence in their lives.

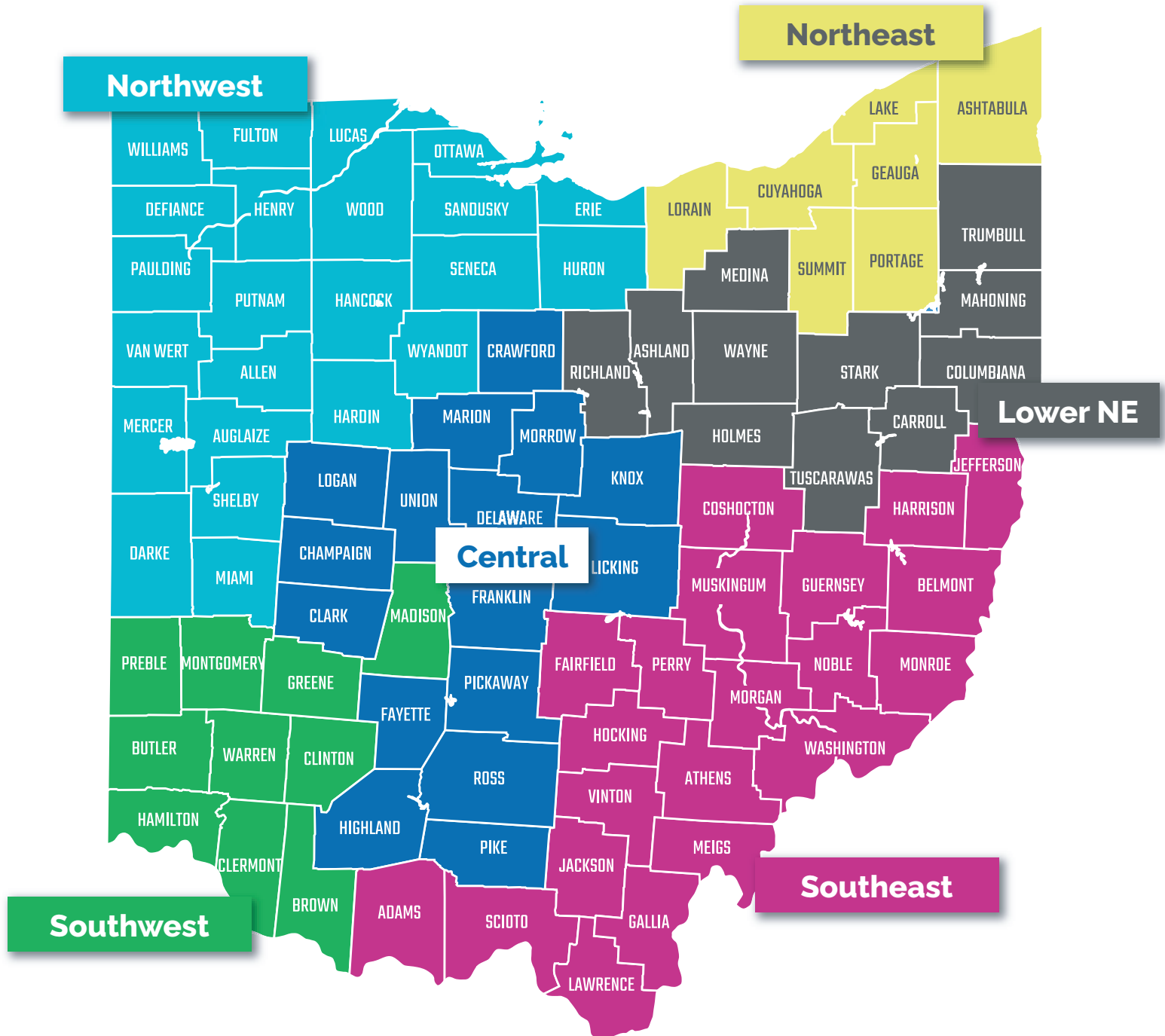
