This directory is a valuable resource guide for family members, service providers, and Parent and Family Peer Supporters who care for children with special needs.

The resources included here specifically address, or generally pertain to, conditions associated with adults and children affected by Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD).

These conditions arise when a baby is exposed to alcohol in utero. Alcohol exposure can impact a child's brain and body development, leading to various challenges in learning, behavior, attention, emotions, and everyday life skills.



FASD Protective Factors

The resources included in this directory specifically address, or generally pertain to, conditions associated with adults and children affected by Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD). Protective factors are positive events and traits that reduce the impact of risk factors. Those factors serve as a reference for the services and resources in this directory.

Early diagnosis: A child who is diagnosed at a young age can be placed in appropriate educational classes and receive the social services needed to help the child and his or her family.

Involvement in special education and social services: Children who receive special education tailored to their specific needs and learning style are more likely to reach their full potential.

Loving, Stable Home Environment: Children with FASD can be more sensitive than other children to disruptions, changes in lifestyle or routines, and harmful relationships. Therefore, having a loving, stable home life is very important for a child with FASD.

Absence of violence: People with FASD who live in stable, non-abusive households or who do not become involved in youth violence are much less likely to develop secondary conditions than children who have been exposed to violence in their lives.

About Parent and Family Peer Supporters

Parent Peer Supporters and Family Peer Supporters are often parents or family members who possess lived experience or training in navigating various service systems. The directory includes listings of agencies that employ or provide peer support.

A Parent and Family Peer Supporter in Ohio is a trained and, in some cases, certified caregiver who uses their own lived experience raising a child with behavioral health challenges to support, guide, and advocate for other families navigating systems and accessing resources.

This directory lists agencies that may employ lay or certified peer supporters, including roles like Certified Peer Recovery Supporters, Family Peer Supporters, and Youth Peer Supporters. Peer roles can be paid or volunteer and may be core or supplemental services. Information is based on public sources and self-reported details, and certification status, staffing, and service availability can vary. Users should contact organizations for the most current information on services and eligibility.

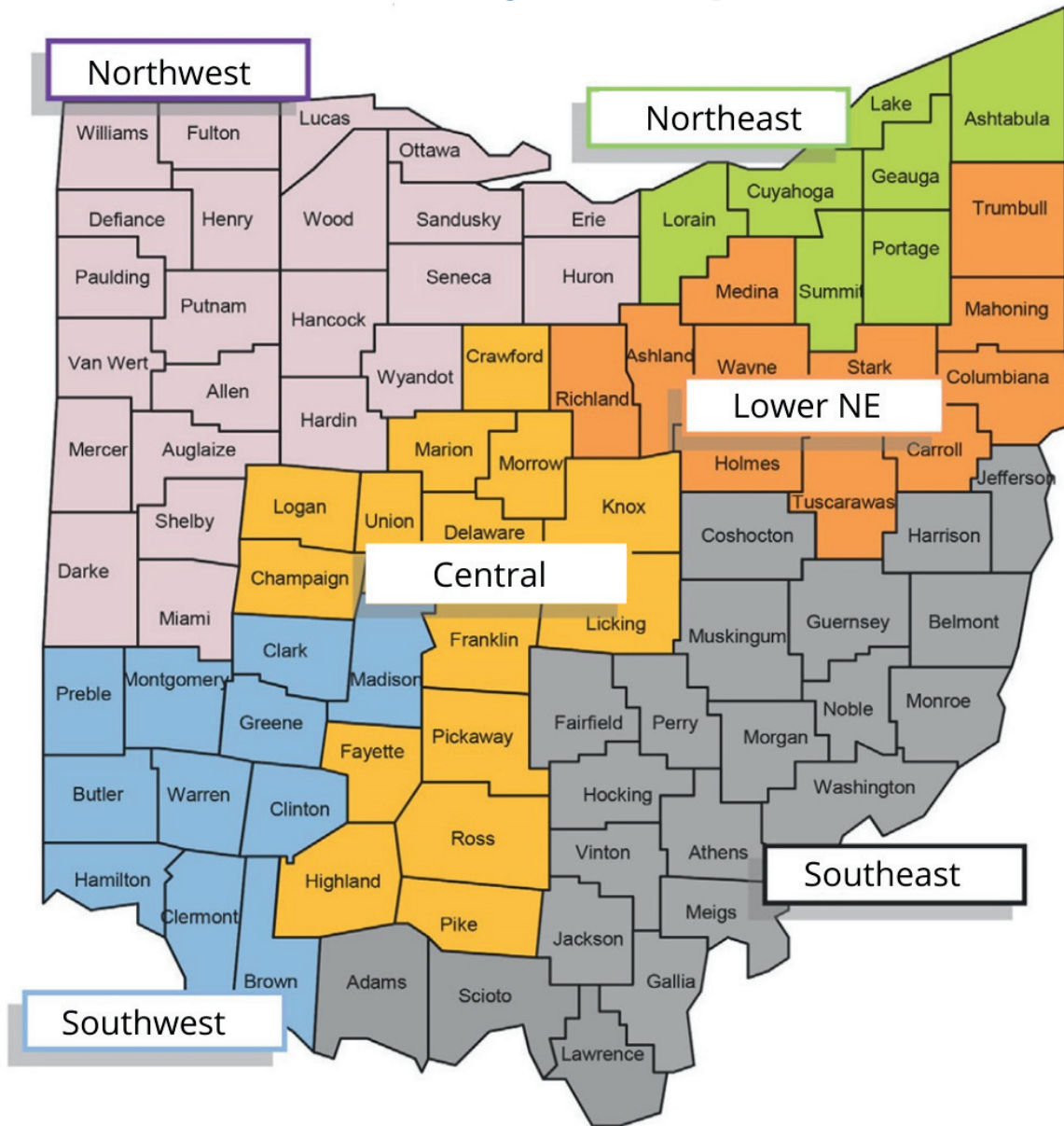

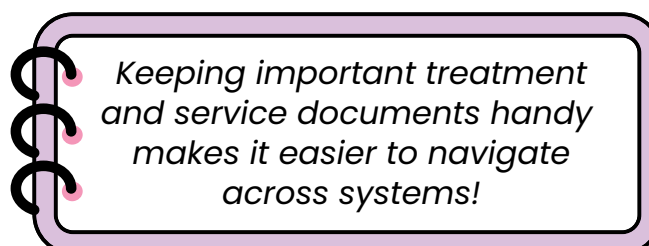
